Family Pathways

Shelter diversion and homelessness prevention program serving 40 families per year

Front Door - Baltimore County | 112 Sudbrook Ln., Pikesville A rapid re-housing and shelter diversion program serving 70 households annually through intensive case management, housing support, client assistance to remove barriers to housing, and short-term rental assistance

Interim Gardens | 112 Sudbrook Ln., Pikesville

10 permanent housing units that serve families with chronic homelessness and physical or mental disabilities, who need long-term support to live independently

Interim House | 112 Sudbrook Ln., Pikesville

10 transitional housing units that serve homeless families who need support to transition from shelter to permanent housing

Structured, therapeutic activities for children ages 5-13 facing moderate to severe behavioral and emotional challenges

Mental health and substance use disorder treatment to adults, children and families, in-home respite services and public school partnerships
