## **WORKFORCE HOUSING**

## **Victory Housing**

79 units of affordable housing for individuals and families:

- Cambridge Apartments | 676 Houston Ave., Takoma Park 33 units; 16 minimum are for households at or below 60% of area median income
- Winslow House | 666 Houston Ave., Takoma Park
   46 units; 23 minimum are for 60% or lower median income
