Approximately 1,000 families receive assistance annually.

 Individual counseling, family counseling, psychiatric evaluation, social and coping skill development, medication management, and substance use disorder services
- School-based mental health services
 Licensed therapists help with emotional and behavioral issues that can impact students at school and at home: improve behavior and school work habits, develop coping and relationship skills, and manage anxiety and depression. Parents and caregivers get support, information and guidance leading to better communication and a less stressful home.
